HERO:

TRADITIONAL HERO

A. a mythological or legendary figure often of divine descent endowed with great strength or ability

B. an illustrious warrior

C. a man admired for his achievements and noble qualities

D. one who shows great courage

LITERARY HERO

A. the principal male character in a literary or dramatic work

B. the central figure in an event, period, or movement

ANTI-HERO

- a main character in a book, play, movie, etc., who does not have the usual good qualities that are expected in a hero
